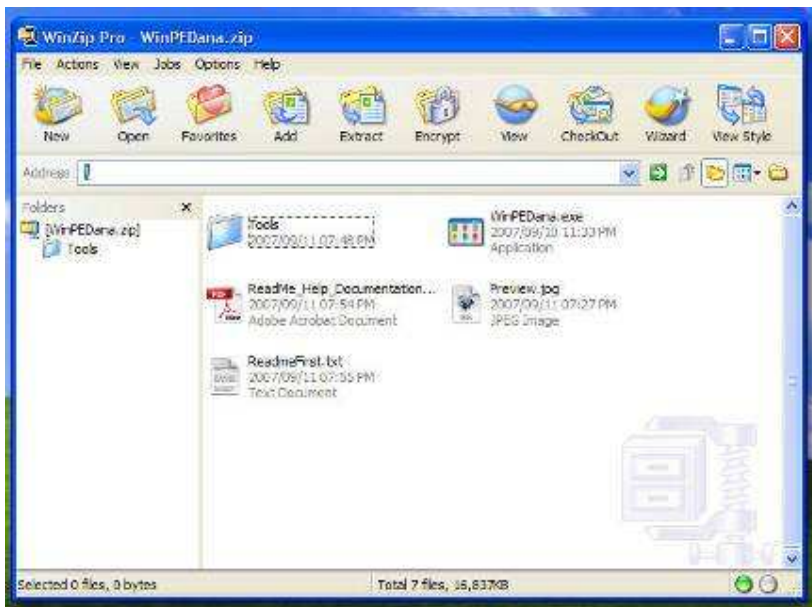




Windows PE X+ Dana International Theme Pack

Help and Information



Thank You very much for downloading Windows PE (Pointed Ears/Purple Elf) + Dana International Theme Pack. I do hope you enjoy the wonderful visual experience on your PC. Please read through this help file first, before continuing, and then work with it. I decided to continue to modify my visual style and do much more than edit the visual style, especially for my one friend Laura where I cannot forget the wonderful time we had together when we first met. This is especially made for her and her Birthday, since she loves me, my elves, my purple-ness, and Dana International, and our personalities are so similar. This help documentation will provide help on how to set it up, and how to solve particular problems should you encounter.

I guess you have already opened the zip file and read the ReadmeFirst.txt before reading this document. Please note that you are free to distribute, as long as you distribute the whole zip file as emphasized in terms and conditions, the main reason is that if people don't get this help documentation with the installers, there systems could be at risk if they not sure what to do.

Now you have opened the zip folder, it is recommended please to print this help documentation out, and keep it when you need help in regards to Windows PE + Dana International Theme Pack. This is what the contents would be...

You would now have to decide weather you going to install Flyakite OS-X or install without it. The difference between the two is that Flyakite OSX provides all the MAC OS X Graphical User Interface elements. It is recommended to Install Flyakite OS X for the best visual experience and performance than just installing Windows PE alone on Windows XP. Any version will do, best the latest version. This is if you wish to have the full windows PE experience. Which includes MAC OS X elements on most things? Windows PE just has a few, which I built on, and it would be right to install Flyakite OS-X. If you find that when you installed it, your PC has gone a bit slower, this is because of the programs it loads in start-up, you can disable them out of start-up, from the control panel which I would discuss in troubleshooting later in this document.

Flyakite OS X provides the features, which enhance the appearance of windows PE, because it contains windows transparency, and shadowing under the windows, which enhance the 3D feel of windows PE. Also you may want to revert to the very well designed Apple Mac GUI, I prefer it better than Vista, and XP (I dislike the XP and Vista , is that cream colour. They included in both styles reminds me of the vomit comet, which was a homemade vehicle that used to be owned by a bunch of people that drove around

Eshowe (the town I spent my high school days in). It had fibreglass shell (ironic and iconic lol), and its colour the creamy vomit colour. Although the downfall of the Apple Mac style looks to plain and white... perfect for those who are completely left brained. However, I like having more colour variation, hence, the Windows PE design that adds a little colour and excitement over the Apple MAC design. Users will then have the standard windows XP style + the apple Mac (Tiger + Panther) + My Purple Elf and its sister the Dana International style.

Step 1: Inatallation

If you decided not to Install Flyakite OS X on your computer before installing windows XP, as you are extremely worried about memory and your PC is less than 128Mbs in RAM.. Go into the tools folder, and install themepatcher now. Please note you will not have the extra features, and full icon coverage Flyakite



OS X , you will have some of the icons changing to Apple Mac icons, due to the fact of the shell32.dll file I modified and added in the package. Please note the Mac icons appear best with the purple elf, and Dana styles, I also find the Apple Mac icons more reliable, more realistic, than the abstract yucky windows XP ones, even Windows Vista, I not happy with there icon design, although it is an improvement from XP, they still like more abstract compared to the Apple Mac icons.

Open Tools, and click on Universal Theme Patcher and install, If you choose Flyakite OS X you need not do this, it has it built in. Click to install by clicking patch, it may ask you to reboot, allow it to reboot your system. This

allows you to install many different visual styles you can download of the Internet, or make your own, and load it. Then you now can go out of tools, go to the main directory of the zip file, and click WinPEDana.exe, which is the installer for Windows PE + Dana International Theme Pack. For to back up your system files, and re-install them, you have to do it manually. Please see troubleshooting section of manually installing system files further down.

My visual styles PurpleElf and DanaInt use less memory than the standard windows XP Luna style even Flyakite's MAC OS X Panther and Tiger styles!! They have been optimised to reduce memory consumption. My older versions used to take up seven to 14 megabytes of memory, on the style alone without running the .mstyle.dlls. Not only there memory consumption is reduced, there file size is smaller, so it is recommended to overwrite my old ones, and make sure you on a MAC OS visual style, default Luna or another style, when you install, as it would not install properly as the old one is still in use, even when you reboot. How memory was consumption was reduced, is I eliminated other colour schemes, since people who installed the older versions , preferred the PurpleElf and Purple2 colour schemes and the DanaInt default colour scheme. The images in the style files were optimised as well, almost all to 256 colours, and simple ones to 16 colours, it is hard to believe when you look at it. This reduces the load of unused colours in memory for the visual style. In fact it would run better than Luna on a slow, memory low PC, that's if you left out Flyakite OS X. But I will tell you later how to reduce memory consumption of Flykite OSX stuff if you installed it.

PurpleElf style = 2.35Mb
DanaInt style = 1.59Mb

If you decide to do the full visual experience, and a safe uninstall of Windows PE system files, even running system file update, removes windows PE system files automatically!! **KEEP THIS DISABLED IF YOU WANT WINDOWS PE ON**, and not removed. If you have it running, you would most likely need to install the windows PE system files manually (Explained in Trouble Shooting) the next time. If you have it running all the time, you will be installing manually till the cows come home.. lol.

Download Flyakite OS X from <http://osx.portraitofakite.com/> save to a folder and open the installer of Flyakite OS X... When you reach this window and **carefully** select the items to install...



Open all the [+] boxes and tick all the other boxes **except the following:**
These options must not be ticked

System Files-

- Exe
 - moviemk.exe (This is windows movie maker, the replacement is faulty)
 - helpctr.exe (It works, but small parts are faulty)

Extras -

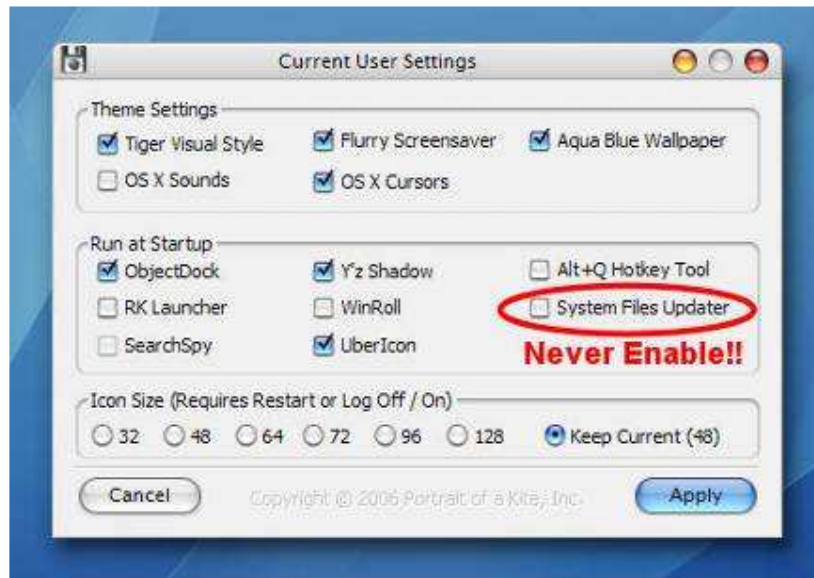
- Boot Screen (Shows Apple icon only when running disk scan, which is not good)
 (There is no "happy" Mac or "sad" Mac like normal Apple)
- Help Support Centre images (not to sure if this is causing the minor problems with help centre)
- Logon Screen, does not load properly in Safe mode, like mine (WinPE)

Tweaks -

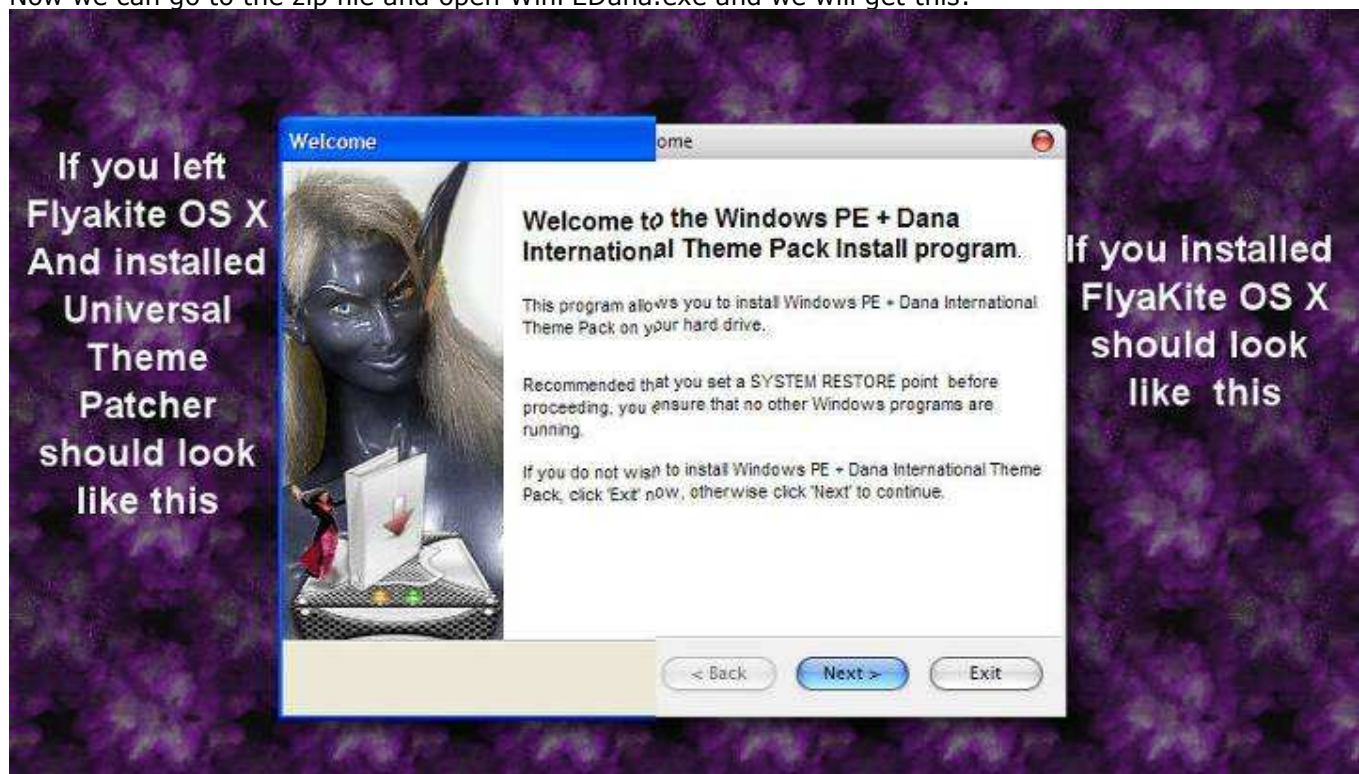
- Make Command Consol like terminal (Changes your command prompt)
- (Version 2) recycle bin hide... but if you select it... and later want to hide and show your recycle bin.. its Explorer\ Hide Desktop Icon \ NewStartPanel... To get instant access to type "New Start Panel" in the C:\WINDOWS\regedit.exe search (Edit\Find menu on regedit) You will see a long number {645FF040-5081-101B-9F08-00AA002F954E} double click it, and the binary value (1) = Hide the recycle bin and the binary value (0) = Show the Recycle Bin.

Read through there documentation and click on all the next buttons (make sure you choose small icons for less memory consumption) and then allow it to reboot your system....

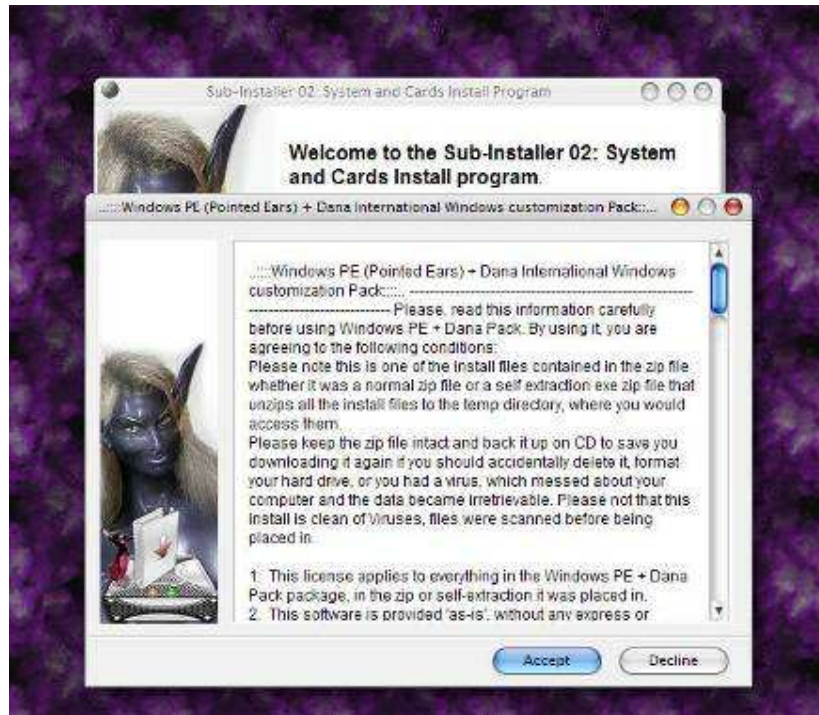
Now after your system has rebooted either from installing the Theme Patcher (Lite-option) or Flyakite OS X option , we are now ready to install windows PE ☺, but if you installed Flyskite OSX make sure that the System File Updater is off and apply. To do that Go to Start Menu\ (All)Programs\Flyakite OSX\Tools\Current user settings. You can also access it in Control Panel\Other Options in the menu bar of Control Panel.



Now we can go to the zip file and open WinPEDana.exe and we will get this:



Read through all my documentation and click the next buttons. You will get a window telling you the directory does not exist, click **Yes** to create it, then **start** and wait for the main installer to load until you get 2 sub-installers (I continue screen caps with the Flyakite OS X visual style.) **Those who have installed older versions of Windows PE and DanaInt, make sure you have either windows xp or OS X style set, as it wont install the style properly!!** If you do, lick exit, close installer and set to any other visual style, and re-open the WinPEDana.exe installer.



You **must** install the sub-installer 01 first, that's the one with the smaller side picture, with the licence agreement first. Click accept, then Install.. and wait. Don't do anything, if it popped up a message telling that you must reboot, click o.k , and do not reboot.



Now you have sub-installer 2 open , install that. That is the system files. If you get little pop ups like these... ignore them, and move them down to the side, and wait for the reboot one to load. And click re-boot.. and your computer will reboot.

Now the installation is complete.

Step 2: Checking System File Installation.

Now we need to check if all the system files were installed, I wish we did not have to do this step I have screen shots on what things should look like after the system files were installed from Sub-Installer 2. I will give the file name, and the program, with the image. Some computers installed all the system files, other computers, only some. If it was none at all, you did not, by looking at specific signs.

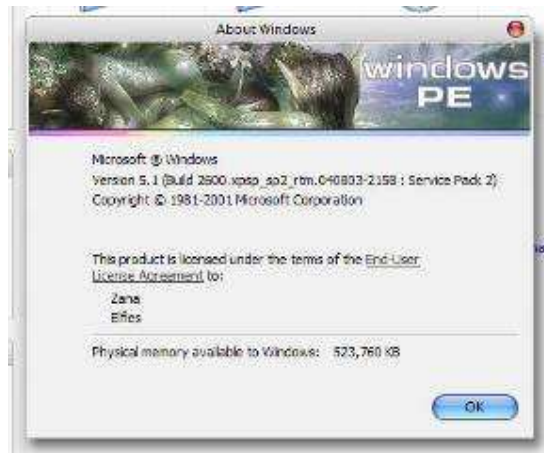
Windows Explorer:: explorer.exe

Right click on the task bar, and then properties and the images of taskbar should look something like this:



(please note that the difference in the clock is actually Lclock, a separate program, that comes with Vista transformation pack or downloaded separately)

System Shell (shell32.dll)



Msgina.dll & Winbrand.dll

Open start menu, and click Logout, look at the dialogue, don't logout..

Then turn off, and the turn off dialogue, do not turn off.

Then right click the desktop, and change them, and back again and look at the please wait dialogue. All of them should look like this.



Then go to control Panel, User Accounts, User Accounts, Change the way users log in and out, untick all of them, and close and log out. If you see this picture, in logging out dialogue, and the logon..



Then it installed, you may have to type your user name and password to enter in if you have no password, just log in without a password, and go to control panel, User Accounts, User Accounts, Change the way users log in and out, tick all, close, and log out and log in again.

Card Games: FreeCell, mshearts, sol. And cards.dll

In the start menu check all the card games games if they have elf cards... eg:



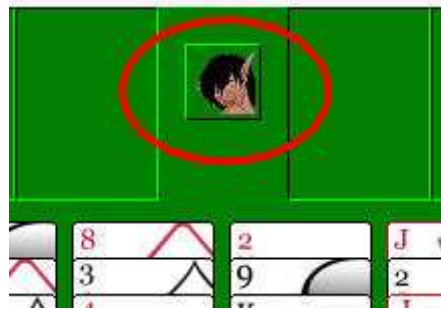
Now let's check each specific thing on 3 of the card games except solitaire, since solitaire uses cards.dll and as well as hearts and FreeCell, except spider. Spider uses its own cards in the program.

MsHearts should have the following features, the names, Kayla, Laura and Dana, as well as an elf language quote (Help/Quote), and English translation; I shall treasure your gift in my heart. And check for elf cards it uses cards.dll.

Spider should have elf cards, and dialogue from Help/About Spider should have a spider woman image, a snapshot, of Borris's painting set to fit in the window. (Some windows XP Home editions it did not install automatically)



FreeCell should have a little elf that moves her head with the mouse in the square instead of a king. (This card game did not install over original in most windows Professional editions, but in most Home editions it installed, and refused to reinstall after Flyakite OS X System was enabled and disabled, and constantly returned to original, even during manual re-install. To sort of solve this, go to trouble shooting.



Take note of what was installed, and what was not, then lets install the styles, logon, and boot(advanced: no help in manual), and then install the system files manually. Troubleshoot – manual install/reinstall.

Step 3: Loading Styles and Themes.

I provided instructions for this since my visual styles are different from others, due to the start menu dimensions, and 3D menus. First we need to load the windows XP base theme. (base_xp or basexp2) DO NOT LOAD base_classic, this is just for backup, and low ram based accounts...

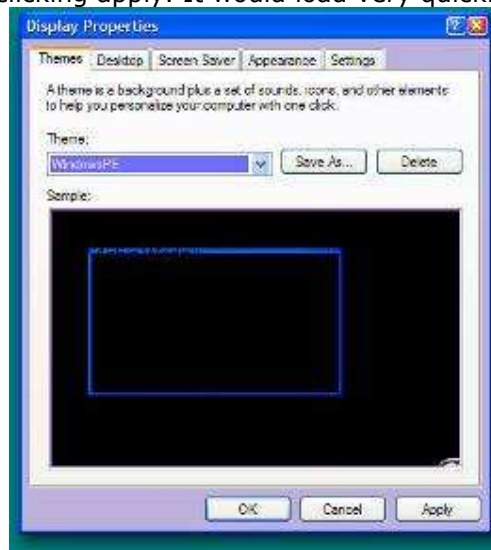
Right click on your documents, and click properties and select (base_xp or basexp2)



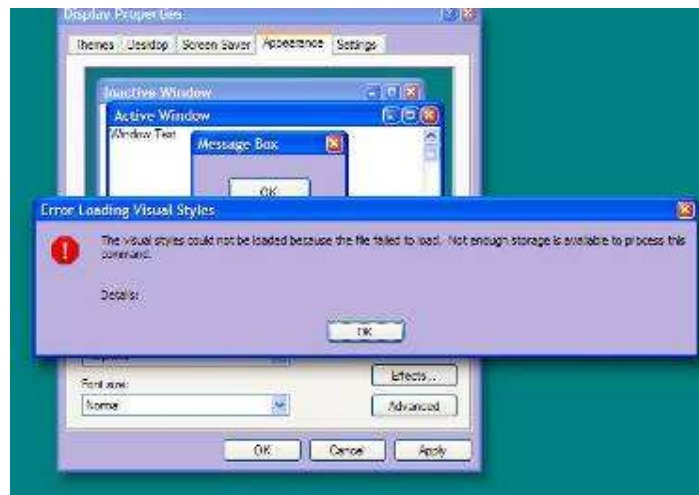
Once that is done, click apply, Close window (important-prevents blackout on some computers depending on graphics card drivers/hardware and memory), and right click on Properties. The windows base_xp and basexp2 contain the elements that normal visual styles do not have, such as the 3D menus and more..

Black out is a very rare, and unpredictable pheromone, where everything turns black-please refer to troubleshooting if that happens, it most likely to happen when there is a constant switching over from my themes and appearances(visual styles) to others, without closing the window, and then going to screen resolution settings and colour display modes. Then changing them , and applying, changing them back etc without closing the window, sometimes it never happens, sometimes it just happens.

Now click properties on desktop, and choose WindowsPE (For Purple Elf) or DanaInt (Dana International) Now please don't worry if you don't see a preview... and because its black in the little preview window, you wont get the blackout when clicking apply. It would load very quickly.



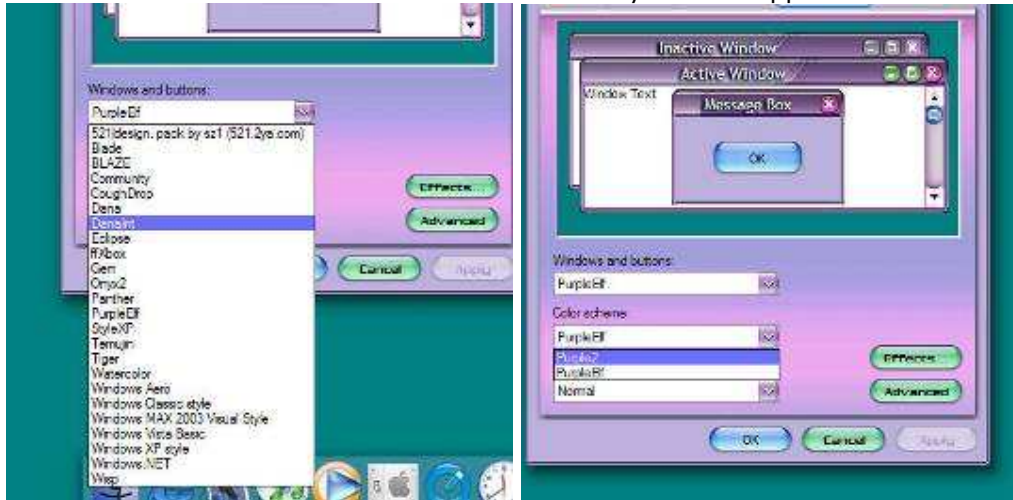
You can also go to the Appearance tabs and Choose DanaInt or Purple Elf. When you get an error message like this.. This is because the images in start menu, and windows does not recognise it in the dialogue, it confuses this dialogue.



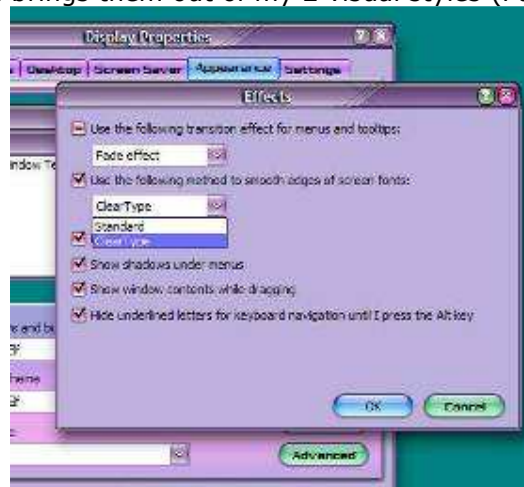
Click o.k, to close, and O.K , to close and load... I chose the Purple Elf, if you do not like the koeksister (the two elves near user name)elves on the start menu, because your username stretches over them, you can choose Purple2. A koeksister is a south African dessert snack, I provide recipe in zip file from a downloaded web page ((^_^)) These are sweet koeksister elfies☺



You can also choose DanaInt to load the Dana International style in the appearance tab.



Once you have the visual style loaded, it is recommended to open this dialogue again and go to effects. This enhances the "secrets" and brings them out of my 2 visual styles (PurpleElf + DanaInt).



Then we add the wallpaper and stuff, and should look like this: You can use Flyakite User Settings to enable MAC OS sounds and cursors, the cursors of MAC OS suit my style too.



Step 3: Loading Logon.

In the zip file go to tools and install logon loader, then run logon loader and browse for the logons in the program. The logons that were installed is Windows PE and Dana_logon.

C:\WINDOWS\resources\logons, and install it like so...



Logout and log on or switch user to test logon screen.

Step 4: Setting Boot.

It is recommended to download boot loader and boot XP.. To load one of the two boot, this is displayed when your computer is booting. Here your Kernel is changed, if you manually change this, you are taking a big risk, I won't describe how to do it, since these boot files may not be directly supported by your version of XP, however a boot loader, or boot manager program will do all for you.. here is an example:



This program is not in the zip file, like Flyakite OS X you can get bootxp here: <http://www.bootxp.net/>

Now we have everything done!!:-), well if you had problems, with some of the system files not installing etc.. its now the troubleshooting.

Troubleshooting

System Files- Manual Installation/Reinstallation

If you did not choose to Install Flyakite OS X, and used the Universal Theme Patcher instead, it is recommended to back up your existing windows XP files, instead of having to reinstall windows if you want the originals, however my modified ones are stable. And have no problems, but if you want them back and know you have a back-up. You can use the methods of manual install to restore them, since its exactly the same. To back them here is the list of sytem files that windows PE installs, or in some cases should install, but does not install correctly , possibly because I used free not to powerfull enough install program compiler, and would need Microsoft Visual C++ to fix the problem, which I don't have that C++ compiler. Manual installation works on all.

The list is

explorer.exe	C:\WINDOWS
cards.dll	C:\WINDOWS\system32
freecell.exe	C:\WINDOWS\system32
msgina.dll	C:\WINDOWS\system32
mshearts.exe	C:\WINDOWS\system32
shell32.dll	C:\WINDOWS\system32

spider.exe	C:\WINDOWS\system32
winbrand.dll	C:\WINDOWS\system32

Go to windows directory, copy explorer, and paste it on desktop.

Go to system32 directory, and click

View\ExplorerBar\Search

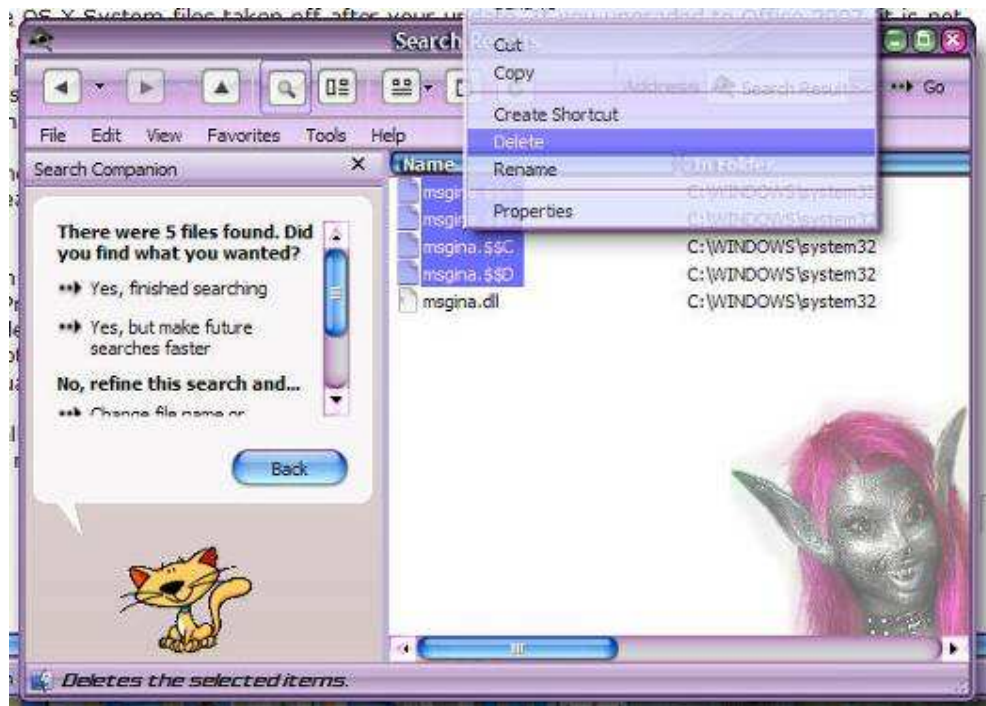
Then type in all the files one by one, and search them, **copy** the relevant file that is in the system32 directory to the desktop. Once you have copied all the listed files onto the desktop, zip them up and store them in a place you wish.



Manual Installation

Manual Installation is used when not all the stuff installed, and if you had to run, Flyakite system files updater, such that for example you upgraded Office for example, and all the office icons changed to the default Microsoft icons, and you wish to update them with the system Updater back to the suitable Apple ones. You will have problems re-installing the windows PE system files and card game stuff. Make sure you have Flyakite OS X System files taken off after your update. If you upgraded to Office 2007, it is not recommended to use the Flyakite OS X system file updater, since they are Office 2003/XP files, in the updater. If there is new version of Flyakite OS X (a version 4 for example) I do not know how its system file updater works, or if it will be embedded, and may have files for Office 2007. Flyakite version 2 if you have and are using do not have this problem, and I presume the windows PE installer will re-install them properly.

Also search for the file names of each, and if there are funny name characters of the original files, delete them from the search when they pop up. These files do not allow proper automatic install, these are hidden backups from the Flyakite OS X System updater, and will prevent automatic installation. Try running the automatic installation one last time once you deleted these, preferably after a reboot/restart of your computer.

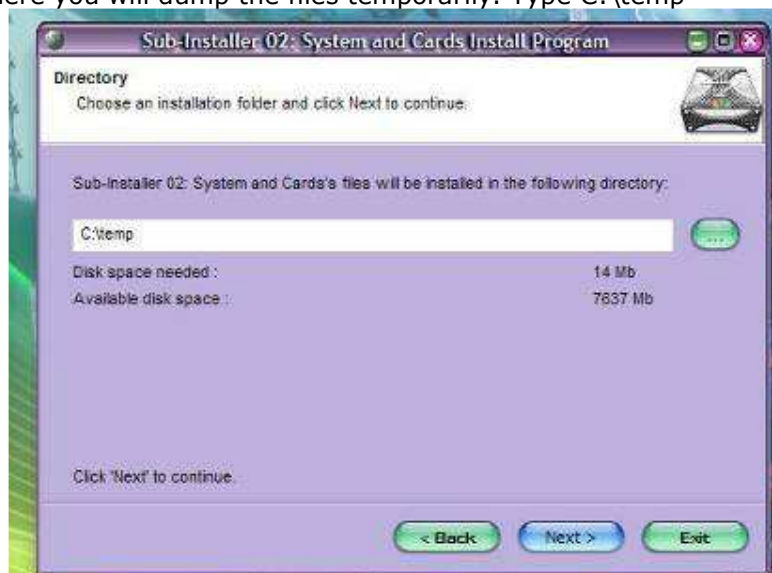


If not all your system files were installed in main installation, it is recommended to go to: Start Menu\All Programs\WindowsPE\Windows PE System Files, click on it and it will run the windows PE system file installer which is a saved copy of the Sun-Installer 2 from main install. In the same menu, about that is the other installer for the visual styles and stuff, and use that if you encountered problems installing the visual styles.

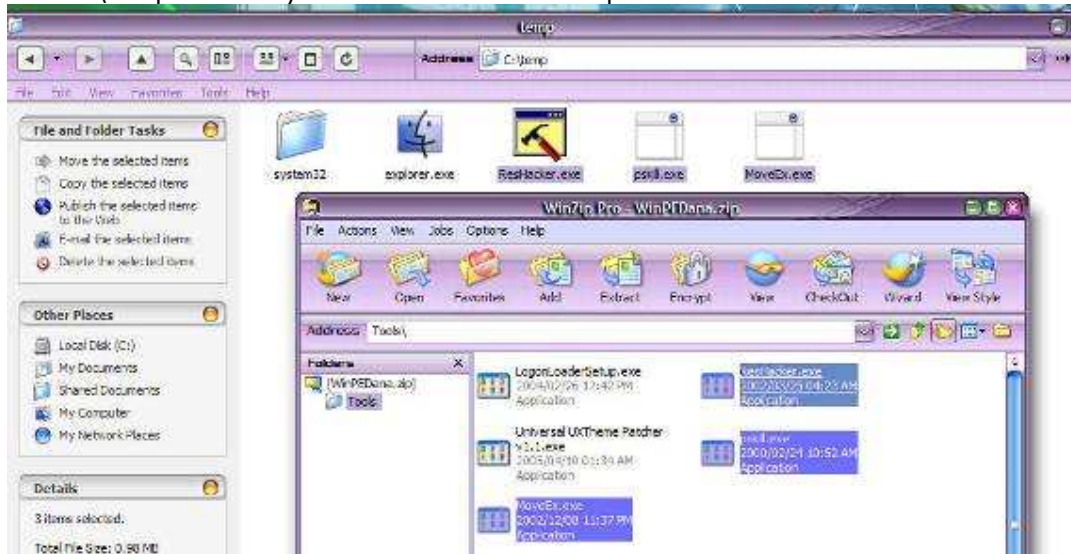
Run system installer and reboot, check the install how you checked earlier, attempt 3 times if there are light changes, or no changes, Sometimes it fixes it all.

If you had no changes, or only some changes, you would have to install them manually by using 2 methods.. Excluding windows Explorer.

What you do, is go back to the start menu, and open the installer, this time change the directory of installation, like so where you will dump the files temporarily. Type C:\temp



Click next, if you don't have this directory, it will ask you to create it, and click o.k./ start and continue, next and then close, until all the files are extracted into the C:\temp folder located on the hard drive. Then open the zip file, go into the tools folder, and extract Reshacker.exe + the program MoveEx.exe and the program pskill.exe. to the C:\temp folder. You may also do this by dragging the Reshacker.exe, from the zip into the c:\temp folder if you have both windows open.



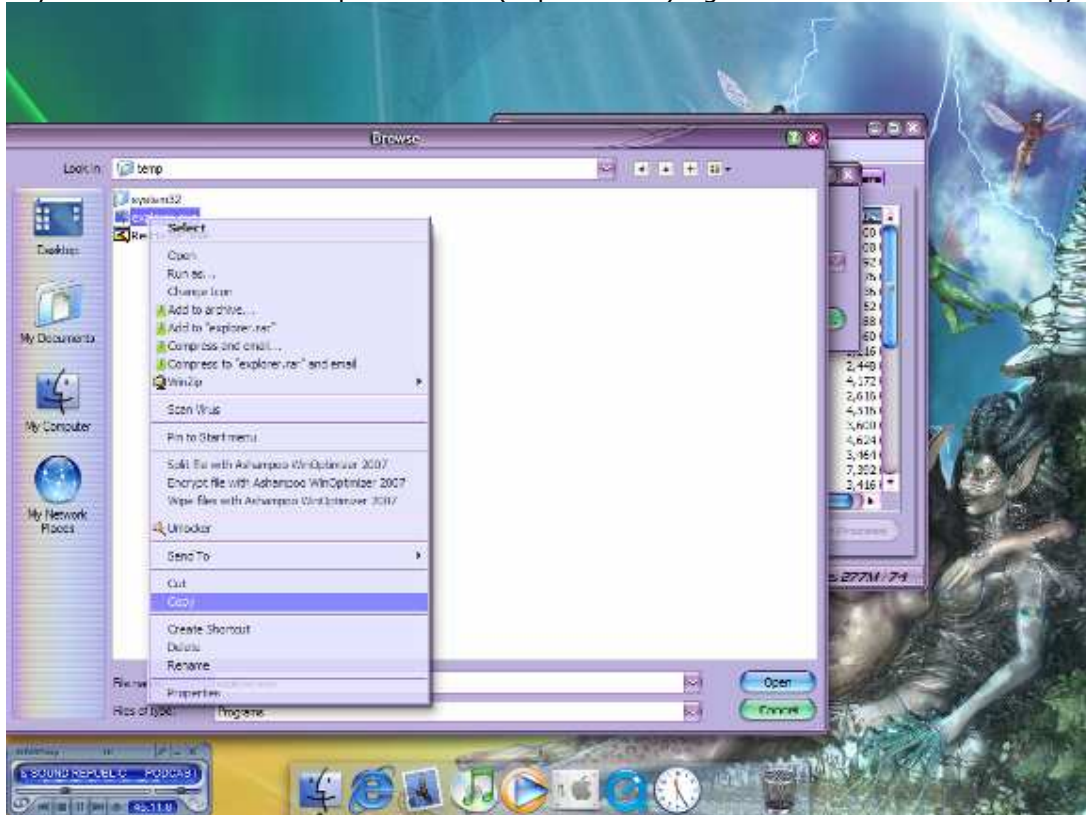
Now you have the necessary files in your little temporary folder. First, if your windows explorer did not install, it's a slightly different way to do it. Compared with the others which you can use one of the two methods, first the easy one using Reshacker.exe and the other by going to your actual system32 folder, scroll and look for your file, rename it , copying the file from your temp folder into the system32 folder, and deleting the renamed old one. And do this with all the ones that did not install correctly, and reboot. (you have to work very carefully in the system32 folder, not to rush- if you rush you bound to make an error, causing possible system failure).

First we do the windows explorer, this is the best way... Pres Alt+CTRL+Del to bring up a dialogue window. Go to the processes tab, and select explorer.exe.



Click on the End process Button. A window will pop up warning you. and click yes, and you will notice your taskbar and desktop icons will vanish, this is normal, now we know the Windows Explorer is not running

and is free to overwrite. Go to file on the Windows Task Manager and new task (not end) if you pressed end by accident, press ALT+CTRL+DEL and bring it up again. (Work carefully... o.k.). Then once you opened new task you see the Run dialogue. Click brows button, and enlarge the browsing window by pulling the bottom right corner.. On the dots. Click My Computer icon on the left bar, then C: drive then temporary... you will see windows explorer there (explorer.exe) right click on it and select copy.



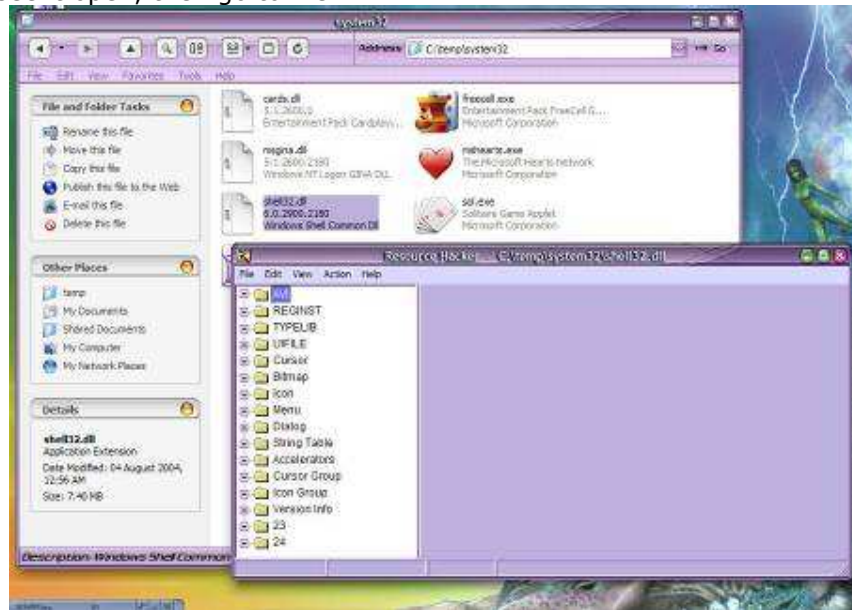
Then click the My computer icon on the left again and go to drive C: , WINDOWS (C:\WINDOWS) Right click on any white space, and select paste, and it will paste internet explorer. Click yes to overwrite.



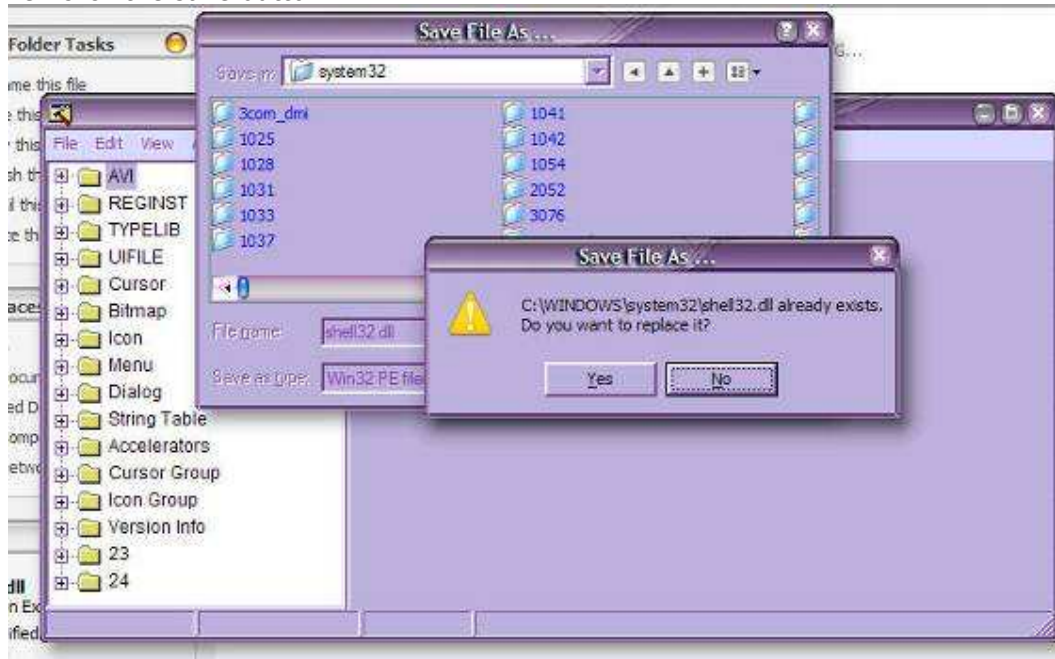
Then close the browse window, and in the run, type explorer.exe
And it will load your taskbar and icons back. Click Help in the Windows Task Manager and about, and see if you see a windows PE dialogue the about window. It should be there since you overwritten it. If you see Mac OS X, you obviously still have Flyakite OS X System update still running, disable it and try again.

METHOD 1: USING RESHACK.EXE

Now with the others, do this only to the ones that did not install correctly, make sure you know which ones, I open shell32. As an example, and this example is used to all of them in the C:\temp\system32 folder to the C:\WINDOWS\system32 folder. Open and run MoveEx.exe and the program pskill.exe, they will open and close in a flash, this unlocks, then open Reshack.exe, and one of them I you wish to start with first. You will see it open, then go to file.



Go to file and click Save as, then a old fashioned looking browse window opens, then click the Save in's ▼ at the top and select My Computer. Select drive C: then go to WINDOWS folder, then system32 folder. There are many files in here, to save time in the save as textbox type the full file name. shell32.dll for example. Then click the save button...



Then yes, then the file is now overwritten. Reshack is actually really used to extract the bitmaps, strings and code from dlls/and some resource exe files, that is how I managed to change them. There will be no need for a reboot; if it saved without a pop up error, (some versions of XP require a reboot manually). Test like what you did earlier after reboot, if it did not work go to method 2.

Do this with all the ones that did not install...earlier automatically.
If you get this error:



We move on method 2.

METHOD 2: Copy, rename original, and paste new, then delete renamed file.

Go to your C:\temp\system32 folder, and copy the stubborn file.

Then go to C:\WINDOWS\system32 folder, and browse till you see the name of the file.. best to select the white area, and choose this option: Arrange files by name (as there are so many) organise them in alphabetical order. Work slowly, carefully in this folder.



1) Find the file, using shell32.dll as an example and rename it to shell32.2.dll, by right clicking and selecting rename. Then paste the copied shell32.dll, next to it, you will see the items in the window reset. Then right click a clear area in the window, and select Arrange Icons\by name then rename the shell32.2.dll to shell32.d.dll.back

Reboot/restart computer

2) Close the window, and open My computer, and go to C:\WINDOWS\system32\ then right click, and select Arrange Icons\by name, , then, rename shell32.2.dll to shell32.2.dll.back , and delete it.



You do this with all the system32 folder dll files, the card games will not require a restart. However the game that you will have problems with most likely is FreeCell, it comes back, but you cannot change it after many tries... I do not know why, an alternative is to rename FreeCell to freecell2.exe and copy it to your system32 folder, and change the location of FreeCell in start menu Programs\Games to select freecell.exe to freecell2.exe. In the start menu of Programs/Games, right click on FreeCell and click properties. In the target text dialogue, Change: %SystemRoot%\System32\freecell.exe To : %SystemRoot%\System32\freecell2.exe And click apply. There you will see the elf.

Some versions of windows XP Home edition, has the problem with Spider Solitaire and not FreeCell, use the same methods for the spider.exe game if you having problems like with the FreeCell.

Flyakite OS X – Memory Consumption Reduction

In order to save memory usage, go to the Flyakite user settings from start menu or control Panel.
 Start Menu → All Programs\FlyakiteOSX\Tools\Current user settings
 Control Panel → on the side bar → Other control Panel options \ Current User Settings.



ALWAYS MAKE SURE SYSTEM FILES UPDATER IS NOT SELECTED when using WindowsPE, as you won't be able to install the system files, or when you try, it will be an ongoing battle of manual installation (like FreeCell) with all the system files! Only use when necessary, and first delete backup, unknown characters, install automatically if it does not work then manually re-install the windows PE system files, or simply manually re-install windows PE system files.

See in run in Startup dialogue, these are extra programs that run when your computer starts, in the background. **Disable all** if you worried about memory, and choose at random, what you need, if you don't need, leave them all switched off. I will provide you a summary what each does.

Object Dock = dock of icons at bottom of screen, alternative is RK launcher. (best one to use)

RK Launcher = dock of icons at bottom of screen

Y'z Shadow = the shadow effect around windows and menu transparency

WinRoll = Minimizes windows to title bar of window, and if middle clicked makes windows transparent. If you have Nvidia graphics card, best to leave this one and use the driver's transparency with nview desktop manager.

UberIcon = Animates Icons when you click on them in windows explorer.

Alt+Q Hotkey Tool = When you press ALT + Q you get the shutdown/restart dialogue.

Theme settings, well when running windows PE visual style and themes, recommended that Tiger Visual Style + Aqua Blue wallpaper are not checked. The others are fine, the Flurry screen saver is one of the most colourful ones I seen, and suits the Windows PE "Theme" with rainbow colours. Disable it if you concerned about memory.

Icon sizes set to the smallest reduce memory a little. (Will prompt you to restart, when you adjust these), 48 is a nice icon size, not too big and not too small. And is suitable for the Windows PE start menu, if you get larger, it would start stretching the elf sketches, or Dana sketches if you using the Dana International visual style.

The "Black-Out"

The blackout is a rare error, which can occur, under the Law of Murphy "Expect the unexpected". This error is caused by the fact my visual styles differ slightly from normal ones, it will most likely to occur, when changing themes + styles (including my own, other styles) , changing the screen resolution, display colours, all at the same time without closing the dialogue window. What happens is all visual elements turn black, and all you can see are icons, and selected text. If you have older computers and no top of the range graphics cards, the chances of it happening increase. However, please not it is rare; just do not change to many settings all at once.

1. Method without restart/reset.

Press the windows icon on your keyboard, you have on either side of space bar, if you using an apple keyboard on your pc, it's the apple icon. (Some people who love Apple, cannot afford one, and buy and use mouse and keyboard from Apple, to get the feel). I like the Apple keyboards, since they have extra USB plug sockets on them, and you can just slip in your camera/flash disk, without touching your tower! ;-)

Press this key, and move the arrows, until you rather see my documents selected, click on that, use arrow keys, to navigate icons, until you get a theme file selected such as basexp.theme selected. Hit the enter key when you reach it, it will look like its opening, and hit the enter key again... and the blackout is over! ;-), and select your saved theme.

2. Method restart/reset safe mode.

Restart and change, reboot computer and go into safe mode, and change the computers theme into windows XP, you don't see any changes, but it is changing, then restart computer and boot in normal mode, and login, and blackness is gone, and select your saved theme.

Information and testing....

I have been developing and modifying and evolving windows PE including the Dana theme for 4 years now, and this is the final, if I should release an update, it will most likely be the installer that would be fixed..

Windows PE has been tried and tested on many computers, each received slightly different results with the system file installs that is what files did not install properly.

I also read online comments from people on deviantart about it, which helped me improve on its visual elements; however, I refuse to take the purple out of the PurpleElf.

Now its has finally become a nice one, and uses very little memory compared to its predecessors, and now less than the default windows XP one! ((^_^)) I find that an achievement. More documentation are in the zip file in a text file...if you want to read through.
